The facts: We will be trophying for the AMA National classes: 50cc (4-8); 65cc (7-11); 85cc Jr. (7-11); 85cc (12-15); super mini (big wheel) (12-15) and girls (12-15).

Points will also be awarded in the NETRA Hare Scramble series by telling us what NETRA class you run in regularly.

All riders must be AMA members.

We will be putting on a second one of these events in August because a rider has to compete in two events for his/her points to be counted nationally.

The rewards: 6 places in each class.

NATIONAL YOUTH HARE SCRAMBLES - We have been awarded two sanctions for 2009 National Youth Hare Scrambles. One is set for the day before the Clarkie Enduro and the 2nd the day before the Pilgrim's Pride Hare Scramble.

These are part of a six race series with other rounds in New York and New Jersey and a rider has to get points in two events for their scores to be counted nationally.

They run six classes:

1. Girls (12 - 15) 80 - 112 cc two stroke / 150cc - four stroke
2. 50cc (4-8) 0-51 cc
3. 65cc (7-11) 52-65 cc two stroke / 52-90 cc - four stroke
4. 85cc Juniors (7-11) 65-85 cc two stroke / 75-125 cc-four stroke
5. 85 cc (12-15) 65-85 cc two stroke / 75-125 cc-four stroke
6. Super Mini (bigwheels) (12-15) 80-112cc two stroke / 75-150cc four stroke.

We intend to run 2 heats. The first for the 50ccs - a one hour run on a 1 mile course. The 2nd will be a 1½ hour run for the remaining classes leaving at 1 minute intervals. The trophies will be awarded by the National Classes but by stating your NETRA number and your NETRA hare scramble class, NETRA points will be awarded for the NETRA champion hare scramble series with any non-NETRA visitor scores removed. An accurate overall time will be kept on all NETRA riders figuring the time difference in the starts. The 50cc heat will be run exactly like our small fry scrambles so don't be concerned about entering this event. The National Points are first (20) to twentieth (1). Put these events on this year's schedule! Don't be afraid to try something different. With NETRA doing away with the grand Prix format for Jr. Enduros (what we were intending to use) we have gone from 4 heats down to 2 heats and the NETRA points are now going to the Hare Scramble series rather than the Jr. Enduro series. On the bright side this gives us a chance to put on one of our small fry scrambles on the afternoons of both these events. Stick around and make a weekend out of both.
