

**NETRA Rule Book Changes for 2012
(approved 12/4/2011)**

Pee Wees

- 1. Article III – Rider/Motorcycle Classifications Section A Rider classes**
Change Pee Wee 2 to read from “up to 100 cc” to “up to 110 cc”

- 2. Article IV – Organizational Requirements Section D – Number of Heats**
The first heat is for Pee Wee III, IV and V Classes.
The second heat is for Pee Wee I and II.

- 3. Article IV – Organizational Requirements Section L – Pre-ride and Sweep Subsection 1**
Prior to each event there will be a parade lap ONLY for Pee Wee III, IV and V classes.
There will be no parade lap required for Pee Wee I & II classes.

- 4. Article V – Organizer/Rider Rules Section A – Starting Positions**
In heat 1, Pee Wee III riders will start first, followed by Pee Wee IV and V riders, in order.
In heat 2, Pee Wee I riders will start first, followed by Pee Wee II riders.

Junior Enduros

- 5. Article IV – Organizational Requirements, Section C – Course Requirements**
All events will have at least one or more timed checks in wooded areas away from other checks.

Enduro and Jr. Enduro

- 6. Article X, Section B and for JR. Enduro: Article X, Section E (4)**
The organizer must supply accurate points tallies to the scorekeeper **and all new memberships and renewals to the NETRA office** within 14 days of the event.

Enduro and Hare Scramble

- 7. Article IX – Promotions Section H – Promotion to B Class** (same sections for both series)
Eliminate the following: “C Veteran, C Senior, or C Super Senior riders have the option to self promote themselves to B class if they want to compete for championship awards. However, having done so, they may not again enter any events as a C rider.”

- 8. Enduro: Article V, Section E Hare Scramble: Article V, Section O**
Add the following (in bold): Organizer club must submit a summary report to the Competition Chairman and Secretary, detailing any and all machines that failed the

sound test. **This report must include machines that initially failed the sound test but then were retested after making modifications or changes to the machine and passed.**

Hare Scrambles

9. Article VII – Scoring and Protests Section A

All Championship events must use NETRA's primary scoring system and a separate back up scoring system, with the Club providing personnel, as requested, and supporting the scoring team.

10. Article X, Section 4.

The event club must send all new memberships and renewals to the NETRA office within 6 days of their hare scramble event. Failure to do so will result in a fine of \$250 and the loss of sanction date if the fine is not paid by the next sanction meeting.

Hare Scramble/Enduro/Jr. Enduro

11. Article X, Section B (Hare Scrambles) Article X, Section B (2) (Enduro) and Article X, Section D (at the end) (Jr. Enduro)

After "must belong to a NETRA competition club" add: **There will be no "backdating" of club affiliation. A rider's club membership, for purposes of championship points, cannot be backdated more than 30 days from the posting of an event in which the rider is not included. It is up to the club to maintain a timely and accurate club database and up to the rider to review results and to make sure that his club listing is correct.**
